# **Fact Sheet**

#### **General Information**

The Cultured Pearl Foundation, Inc. has established the Joyce Yerwood Memorial Scholarship to honor the first African American female doctor in the State of Connecticut. In 1943, Dr. Joyce Yerwood founded the Stamford Negro Community Center. In 1950, it became the West Main Street Community Center, and in 1975, the name was changed to the Yerwood Center, in recognition of Dr. Yerwood's many years of unwavering support and dedication to the community. This scholarship is intended to honor the unique qualities of Dr. Yerwood: the combination of social commitment and scholarship.

#### Eligibility

Applicants should be female high school senior students attending high school in Fairfield County, CT.

#### Criteria

Applicants must

- be enrolled full-time as a high school student
- have a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.75 ("B-") or better
- show participation in volunteer, civic and community service activities
- demonstrate academic achievement
- show evidence of good character and significant service to the local community and/or their respective high school

Applicants should identify honors/awards received, complete the Personal Statement section of the application, submit letters of recommendation from a teacher and guidance counselor, and arrange for an official (unopened) transcript with cumulative GPA to be sent directly to the Foundation.

#### Selection

Application materials will be reviewed by members of the Foundation's Scholarship Committee. Recommendations by the Scholarship Committee will be subject to final approval by the Foundation's Board of Directors.

#### Award Information

Awards will range from \$1,000-\$2,000. This is a one-time award. Legitimate expenditures include tuition, room/board, coursework fees, books and supplies and local transportation.

#### **Application Due Date**

Applications must be electronically submitted via our website or emailed no later than May 11, 2024. Applications submitted after this date will not be considered. Walk-in applications will not be accepted.
