

Kamper/Kaleo Eligibility Restrictions

Anyone who has any of the following CANNOT attend KAA:

PREGNANCY	SICKLE CELL DISEASE	VISION/HEARING IMPAIRED	WHEELCHAIR BOUND/PARALYSIS:

COGNITIVE DELAYS: AUTISM, DOWN SYNDROME, SEVERE DEVELOPMENTAL DELAYS OR SIMILAR SPECIAL NEEDS			
REQUIRES ONE ON ONE ASSISTANCE TO WALK, DRESS, EAT, BATHE, USE THE BATHROOM OR PARTICIPATE IN KAMP ACTIVITIES			
RESPONDS DEFIANTLY TO CORRECTION BY ADULTS OR WHO WERE DEFIANT OF KAMP RULES IN PREVIOUS YEARS			
UNREGULATED DIABETES OR THOSE DIAGNOSED WITHIN 12 MOS OR UNDER 12 YRS. OLD			

*Psychotropic medication: Any medication capable of affecting the mind, emotions, and behavior.

Special Health and Attendance Notes

- *Participants must be in general good health and able to participate in the required walking and athletic activities typical of our Kamp.
- *KAA does not restrict the attendance of those who are Juvenile Delinquents/Wards of the state. However, you must only bring those who respond well to authority & can participate well with other Kampers.
- *KAA is not equipped to handle food allergies or special dietary needs.
- *Regulated diabetics MUST be cleared through the Health Services Director BEFORE attending. This is very important to ensure that proper medications and medical history information is provided to the summer Kamp nurses.
- *Inhalers are primarily kept by the Kampers and Kounselors or the Health Center as needed as a secondary measure.
- *All medication, medical equipment & supplies must be labeled with Kampers/Kaleos name and dosing information.
