Youth Expectations

To ensure the safety and well-being of all participants in the CETC Construction Summer Camp, youth participants will be asked to abide by the following guidelines:

- Students and/or their parents/guardians are responsible for transportation to and from camp.
- Students are to arrive each day between 8:30-8:45am and be picked up between 3:00-3:15pm.
- Students are required to wear long pants (e.g. jeans), flat closed-toed shoes, their camp t-shirt (distributed on Monday), no jewelry, and hair at or below shoulders pulled back in a tie.
- Camp will supply some snacks, water, a refillable water-bottle, and lunch on Friday. Students are responsible for all other food and beverages.
- Students will conduct themselves in a courteous manner and treat their peers, parents, volunteers, staff, community members, and others with respect. Appropriate language and behavior are expected at all times.
- Commitment to safety, teamwork and following instructions is a requirement of participating. Distractions such as using personal electronic devices are to be avoided during camp. Students will respect and adhere to the rules and guidelines of the program and of the site including those specific to the CET Collaborative, or the Conejo Valley Unified School District.
- Students shall obey local, state, and federal laws.

Participants who fail to adhere to the above Code and Requirements are, at the discretion of the CET Collaborative organization, subject to dismissal from the program without refund.

CET Collaborative is responsible for ensuring all instructors and staff practice Operational Risk Management Planning to ensure safety for all students and others throughout the training camp. Each student will be provided a safety briefing before beginning of lesson or activity/project. All personal protective equipment will be provided by the Camp.

Parent/Guardian Permission and Liability Release

I, the undersigned, individual and as the parent and or legal guardian of the above-named youth, a minor, give permission to participate in the CETC Construction Summer Camp June 17-21, 2024 at Thousand Oaks High School.

I understand that camp activities are intended to provide hands-on experience in a construction work environment. Activities may include electrical wiring performed without power connections, welding, cutting with a torch, power equipment, heavy machinery, and carpentry exercises.

In consideration of this participation, I do hereby agree to release, discharge, and hold harmless the CET Collaborative, its partners, officers, agents, and employees of and from all causes, liabilities, damages, claims, or demands whatsoever on account of any injury or accident involving the said minor arising out of my child's participation in the program/project activities.

I agree that in the event medical attention is necessary for my child, I hereby authorize the camp director(s) on my behalf to arrange for medical care (including first aid) at their discretion. Camp staff will attempt to contact parent/guardian in emergency events. I further agree to release CET Collaborative, its partners, officers, agents, and employees from any claim whatsoever that might arise on account of any such medical treatment.

Media Release

I, as the parent or legal guardian of the above named youth, do hereby give permission to the CET Collaborative and/or its partners, agents or employees to use photographs and/or video taken of my/our child during this program for use in promotional and educational materials and to use such photographs/video in electronic versions of the same publications or on organization sites or other electronic forms of media, and to offer them for use or distribution in other media outlets, electronic or otherwise, without notifying me/us.
